2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Underground Utility Facilities
Damage Prevention Act is amended by changing Section 14 as
follows:

7 (220 ILCS 50/14) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 1614)

Sec. 14. Home rule. The regulation of underground utility 8 9 facilities and CATS facilities damage prevention, as provided for in this Act, is an exclusive power and function of the 10 State. A home rule unit may not regulate underground utility 11 facilities and CATS facilities damage prevention, as provided 12 for in this Act. All units of local government, including home 13 14 rule units that are not municipalities of more than 1,000,000 persons, must comply with the provisions of this Act. To this 15 16 extent, this This Section is a denial and limitation of home 17 rule powers and functions under subsection (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution. A home rule 18 19 municipality of more than 1,000,000 persons may regulate underground utility facilities and CATS facilities damage 20 21 prevention.
