5	(4) Three members of the General Assembly chosen by the
6	Minority Leader of the Senate.
7	The purpose of the working group shall be to provide input
8	and advice to the Department and the Office of the Governor
9	with regard to the development of the proposal to utilize a
10	research and demonstration waiver. The working group shall meet
11	initially at the call of the Speaker of the House of
12	Representatives and the President of the Senate and at least
13	once each quarter year thereafter until the waiver either is
14	approved by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services or
15	expires. The Department shall provide administrative support
16	for the working group.
17	Members shall not be compensated for their participation in
18	the working group but may receive reimbursement for travel
19	expenses. The working group shall be dissolved on the date of
20	federal approval or expiration of the research and
21	demonstration project waiver proposal submitted to the U.S.
22	Department of Health and Human Services on June 4, 2014 under
23	Section 1115 of the Social Security Act.
