1 Section 5. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 2 the amount of \$1,951,200, or so much thereof as may be 3 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 4 the Criminal Justice Information Authority for operational 5 expenses, awards, grants and permanent improvements for the 6 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

Section 10. The sum of \$10,750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for administrative costs, awards and grants for the Adult Redeploy Programs.

2 Section 25. The amount of \$1,949,000, or so much thereof 3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 4 Fund to Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for 5 grants and administrative expenses related to Operation 6 CeaseFire.

7 Section 30. The amount of \$634,900, or so much thereof 8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 9 Fund to Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for 10 operational expenses and awards in support of Federal 11 Assistance Programs administered by the State and Local 12 Governments and Non-Profit Organizations.
