

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$397,073,100, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
7 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant
8 awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program,
9 as provided by law, and for agency administrative and
10 operational costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total
11 appropriation in this Section.

12 Section 10. The sum of \$274,601,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
14 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for
15 distribution of base operating and equalization grants to
16 qualifying public community colleges and the City Colleges of
17 Chicago for educational related expenses.

18 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much
19 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
20 Community College Board for all costs associated with career

1 and technical education activities:

2 From the General Revenue Fund17,569,400

3 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much of
4 those amounts as may be necessary, for the objects and
5 purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois Community
6 College Board for adult education and literacy activities:

7 From the General Revenue Fund:

8 For payment of costs associated
9 with education and educational-related
10 services to local eligible providers
11 for adult education and
12 literacy21,572,400

13 For payment of costs associated
14 with education and educational-related
15 services to local eligible providers
16 for performance-based awards10,701,600

18 ARTICLE 998

19 Section 998. The appropriation authority granted in this
20 Act shall be valid only for costs incurred July 1, 2015 to
21 June 30, 2016.
