Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 1-15. The sum of \$50,300, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller from the State Lottery Fund for expenses in connection with the State Lottery.
