1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2157

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2157 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Public Community College Act is amended by
5 adding Section 3-8.5 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 805/3-8.5 new)

7 Sec. 3-8.5. Community college trustee's leadership
8 training.

9 (a) Every voting member of a board elected or appointed for
10 an elected trustee for a term beginning after the effective
11 date of this amendatory Act of the 99th General Assembly shall
12 complete a minimum of 4 hours of professional development
13 leadership training covering topics in community college and
14 labor law, opening meetings law, freedom of information law,
15 ethics, sexual violence on campus, financial oversight and
16 accountability, audits, and fiduciary responsibilities of a

1 community college trustee during the first, third, and fifth
2 year of his or her term. The community college district shall
3 maintain on its Internet website, if any, the names of all
4 elected voting trustees of the board who have successfully
5 completed the training.

6 (b) The training under this Section may be provided by an
7 association established under this Code for the purpose of
8 training community college district board trustees or by other
9 qualified providers approved by the State Board, in
10 consultation with an association so established.

11 (c) The board member shall certify completion of the
12 training required under this Section to the secretary of the
13 board. If the certification indicates that a board member has
14 not completed the training, the secretary shall send a notice
15 to the chairperson of the board and the president or acting
16 chief executive officer of the community college of that fact,
17 and the board shall suspend the member from continued service,
18 at which point, the member has 45 days to complete all training
19 deemed incomplete as provided by the certification. Failure of
20 the board member to complete the necessary training within this
21 probationary period constitutes a resignation from and creates
22 a vacancy in the board, which vacancy shall be filled as
23 provided under subsection (d) of Section 3-7 of this Act.

24 (d) This Section applies to all community college districts
25 with elected board trustees serving pursuant to this Article
26 who have been elected after the effective date of this

1 amendatory Act of the 99th General Assembly or appointed to
2 fill a vacancy of at least one year's duration of an elected
3 trustee after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the
4 99th General Assembly."
