1 commissioners shall excuse a prospective juror from jury service if the prospective juror shows that such service would 2 impose an undue hardship on account of the nature of the 3 4 prospective juror's occupation, business affairs, physical 5 health, family situation, active duty in the Illinois National Guard or Illinois Naval Militia, or other personal affairs, and 6 7 cause his or her name to be returned to the jury list or 8 general jury list.

9 (b) When an undue hardship caused by a family situation is 10 due to the prospective juror being the primary care giver of a 11 person with a mental or physical disability, a person with a medically diagnosed behavior problem, or a child under age 12, 12 13 then the county board, jury commissioners or jury administrator 14 shall excuse such a prospective juror, if it finds that no 15 reasonable alternative care is feasible which would not impose 16 an undue hardship on the prospective juror or the person for whom the prospective juror is providing care, or both. 17
