1 of the reporting categories. The report must include any 2 assumptions concerning tax rates and fees used to determine revenue and expenditures for future fiscal years. The report 3 4 must include a comparison of the enacted current fiscal year 5 budget to the current fiscal year outlook, and, if applicable, 6 must outline any budgetary shortfalls and fiscal and policy options that the Office will pursue to remedy those budgetary 7 shortfalls. If the projected expenditures for any of the 8 9 following 4 fiscal years exceeds the corresponding fiscal year 10 projected revenues, then the report must outline fiscal and 11 policy options that the Office will pursue to remedy the budgetary shortfall. The report must include an agency 12 13 categorization key for the reporting categories. The report must be posted on the Office's Internet website and allow 14 15 members of the public to post comments concerning the report. (Source: P.A. 98-692, eff. 7-1-14.) 16

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.".
