1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3003

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 3003 on page 1,  
3 line 5, by replacing "2.11" with "2.10, 2.11,"; and

4 on page 1, immediately below line 5, by inserting the  
5 following:

6 "(520 ILCS 5/2.10) (from Ch. 61, par. 2.10)

7 Sec. 2.10. The Department may, on an annual basis,  
8 establish a spring wild turkey open season within the period  
9 beginning on March 1 and running through May 31, and a fall  
10 wild turkey season within the period beginning on October 1 and  
11 running through January 31. The Department may, on an annual  
12 basis, establish a youth-only spring wild turkey season which  
13 shall include 2 consecutive weekends. It shall be unlawful for  
14 any person to take wild turkey without possessing a valid "Wild  
15 Turkey Hunting Permit". Persons holding a spring permit may  
16 take female wild turkeys with visible beards or male wild

1 turkeys during the spring open season. Persons holding a fall  
2 permit may take turkeys of either sex during the fall open  
3 season. The Department shall cause notice of administrative  
4 rules setting forth the prescribed rules and regulations,  
5 including those counties of the State where open seasons are  
6 established, to be given in accordance with Sections 1.3 and  
7 1.13.
