- Sec. 11-6-9. Purchase of tires under joint purchasing authority.
- 9 (a) If authorized by the fire chief of the fire department, any regularly enrolled volunteer firefighter may purchase 4 10 vehicle tires every 3 years through his or her fire 11 12 department's or municipality's contract to purchase vehicle tires under Section 2 of the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act. 13 The authorization must be in writing and on the fire 14 department's letterhead, and must include the volunteer 15 16 firefighter's name, the license plate number of the vehicle for the authorized purchase, and must reference the fire 17 department's or municipality's joint purchasing agreement.
