8 Section 10. The amounts appropriated for repairs and maintenance, and other capital improvements in Sections 5 and 9 10 repairs and maintenance, roof repairs and/or replacements, and miscellaneous capital improvements at the 11 12 Department's various institutions are to include 13 construction, reconstruction, improvements, repairs installation of capital facilities, costs of planning, 14 15 supplies, materials and all other expenses required for roof 16 other types of repairs and maintenance, capital 17 improvements, and purchase of land.

No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements from appropriations made in Sections 5 and 40 of this Article until after the purposes and amounts have been approved in writing by the Governor.

8 ARTICLE 2

9 Section 1. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sex Offender 11 Management Board Fund to the Sex Offender Management Board 12 for the purposes authorized by the Sex Offender Management 13 Board Act including, but not limited to, sex offender 14 evaluation, treatment, and monitoring programs and grants. 15 Funding received from private sources is to be expended in 16 accordance with the terms and conditions placed upon the 17 funding.

18 ARTICLE 3

Section 1. The sum of \$795,200, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Corrections from the General Revenue Fund for a grant to the 1 Illinois Sentencing Policy Advisory Council.

- 3 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 4 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
- 5 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- 6 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
