Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and 7 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the 8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of 9 Military Affairs:

4 Section 15. The sum of \$7,400, or so much thereof as may 5 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 6 to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant 7 General Division for expenses related to the care and 8 preservation of historic artifacts.

9 Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Military Affairs 11 Trust Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Office of 12 the Adjutant General Division to support youth and other 13 programs, provided such amounts shall not exceed funds to be 14 made available from public or private sources.

15 Section 25. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military 17 Family Relief Fund to the Department of Military Affairs 18 Office of the Adjutant General Division for the issuance of 19 grants to persons or families of persons who are members of 20 the Illinois National Guard or Illinois residents who are 21 members of the armed forces of the United States and who have 22 been called to active duty as a result of the September 11,

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2 Section 30. The sum of \$800,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 4 Fund to the Department of Military Affairs for deposit into 5 the Federal Agreement Revolving Fund.

6 Section 35. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 8 the Department of Military Affairs for a grant to the 9 Veterans' Assistance Commission of Cook County.

10 Section 40. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the U.S.S. Illinois 12 Commissioning Fund to the Department of Military Affairs to 13 make grants to the U.S.S. Illinois Commissioning Committee.

14 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 15 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General 16 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced 17 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
