Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Community College Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, as follows:

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board  
9 for ordinary and contingent expenses:

10	For Personal Services .....	1,152,300
11	For State Contributions to Social	
12	Security, for Medicare .....	16,000
13	For Contractual Services .....	293,300
14	For Travel .....	45,600
15	For Commodities .....	4,900
16	For Printing .....	5,900
17	For Equipment .....	3,900
18	For Electronic Data Processing .....	389,500
19	For Telecommunications .....	23,200
20	For Operation of Automotive Equipment .....	<u>3,300</u>
21	Total	\$1,937,900

1           Section 10. The sum of \$958,000, or so much thereof as  
2           may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
3           Fund to Illinois Community College Board for costs associated  
4           with administering GED tests.

5           Section 15. The sum of \$2,665,000, or so much thereof as  
6           may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7           Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to  
8           the alternative schools network and other providers for  
9           educational purposes or bridge programs.

10          Section 20. The sum of \$150,000 or so much thereof as  
11          may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
12          Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for support of  
13          the P-20 Council.

14          Section 25. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof  
15          as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
16          Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for Career and  
17          Technical Education Licensed Practical Nurse and Registered  
18          Nurse Preparation.

19          Section 30. The sum of \$60,200, or so much thereof as  
20          may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
21          Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for awarding

1 scholarships to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's  
2 Challenge Program.

3 Section 35. The sum of \$13,762,200, or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
5 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the City  
6 Colleges of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

7 Section 40. The following named amounts, or so much  
8 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
9 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community  
10 College Board for distribution to qualifying public community  
11 colleges for the purposes specified:

12	Small College Grants .....	550,000
13	Retirees Health Insurance Grants .....	0
14	Workforce Development Grants .....	0
15	Performance Funding Grants .....	<u>9,500,000</u>
16	Total	\$10,050,000

17 Section 45. The sum of \$488,800, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
19 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs  
20 associated with the development, support or administration of  
21 the Illinois Longitudinal Data System.

1 Section 50. The sum of \$1,457,900, or so much thereof as  
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 3 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to  
 4 operate an educational facility in the former community  
 5 college district #541 in East St. Louis.

6 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much  
 7 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
 8 Community College Board for all costs associated with career  
 9 and technical education activities:

10	From the General Revenue Fund .....	17,569,400
11	From the Career and Technical Education Fund .....	<u>18,500,000</u>
12	Total	\$36,069,400

13 Section 60. The following named amounts, or so much of  
 14 those amounts as may be necessary, for the objects and  
 15 purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois Community  
 16 College Board for adult education and literacy activities:

17 From the General Revenue Fund:

18	For payment of costs associated	
19	with education and educational-related	
20	services to local eligible providers	
21	for adult education and	
22	literacy .....	21,572,400
23	For payment of costs associated	

1 with education and educational-related  
2 services to local eligible providers  
3 for performance-based awards .....10,701,600  
4 For operational expenses of and  
5 for payment of costs associated with  
6 education and educational-related  
7 services to recipients of Public  
8 Assistance, and, if any funds remain,  
9 for costs associated with  
10 education and educational-related  
11 services to local eligible providers  
12 for adult education and literacy .....0  
13 From the ICCB Adult Education Fund:  
14 For payment of costs associated with  
15 education and educational-related  
16 services to local eligible providers  
17 and to Support Leadership Activities,  
18 as Defined by U.S.D.O.E.  
19 for adult education and literacy  
20 as provided by the United States  
21 Department of Education .....23,250,000  
22 Total \$55,524,000

23 Section 65. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
24 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the

1 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College  
 2 Board for distribution to qualifying public community  
 3 colleges for the purposes specified:

4	Base Operating Grants .....	182,637,200
5	Equalization Grants .....	<u>73,870,500</u>
6	Total	\$256,507,700

7 Section 70. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as  
 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instructional  
 9 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to  
 10 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated  
 11 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.

12 Section 75. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the High School  
 14 Equivalency Testing Fund to the Illinois Community College  
 15 Board for costs associated with administering high school  
 16 equivalency tests.

17 Section 80. The sum of \$12,500,000, or so much thereof  
 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
 19 Community College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the  
 20 Illinois Community College Board to be expended under the  
 21 terms and conditions associated with the moneys being  
 22 received, including prior year expenditures.

1           Section 85. The sum of \$525,000, or so much thereof as  
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust  
3 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and  
4 contingency expenses of the Board.

5           Section 90. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult  
7 Education Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for  
8 operational expenses associated with administration of adult  
9 education and literacy activities.

10          Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
11 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99<sup>th</sup> General  
12 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced  
13 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
