- RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State's Office shall provide staff and administrative support to the Task Force; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall examine and make 11 recommendations related to the feasibility and cost of the 12 Secretary of State issuing electronic or "virtual" driver's 13 licenses to Illinois residents, in addition to currently 14 accepted forms of identification; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall meet at least 3 times and shall report its findings to the General Assembly on or before December 31, 2015; and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall be dissolved after 19 submitting its findings to the General Assembly.".
