WHEREAS, Peter Gerontes was Policeman of the Year in 1965 and was awarded the Combat Valor Award in October of 1966; and

WHEREAS, Peter Gerontes was preceded in death by his parents; and

WHEREAS, Peter Gerontes is survived by his wife, Judith; his children, Nicholas P. (Cynthia) Gerontes, Lisa (Joseph) Gerontes-Bowe, and Gregory (Karen) Gerontes; his 6 grandchildren, J. Michael Bowe, Chloe Bowe, Katherine Gerontes, Matthew Gerontes, Eleni Gerontes, and Lt. Jason Gerontes; his sister, Helen S.
