2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Peter Gerontes of Peoria, who passed away 4 on October 7, 2015; and

5 WHEREAS, Peter Gerontes was born in Peoria on March 24, 6 1931 to Socrates and Katherine (nee Litsadorpoulas) Gerontes; 7 he attended Woodruff High School and served in the United 8 States Army during the Korean War; he married Judith E. Worries 9 on May 10, 1959 at All Saints Greek Orthodox Church in Peoria; 10 and

11 WHEREAS, Peter Gerontes joined the Peoria Police 12 Department in 1958, working there for 27 years and attaining 13 the rank of Sergeant; he assisted in the development of the 14 first Crime Scene Unit Forensics Lab at the Peoria Police Department; it was there that he provided the first fingerprint 15 as evidence that led to a murder conviction in Peoria County; 16 17 he later joined the Peoria County Sheriff's Department in 1985 18 at the rank of Captain, retiring as Field Operations Commander; 19 and
