2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Donald James Lanpher of Rock Island, who 4 passed away on March 25, 2016; and

5 WHEREAS, Donald Lanpher was born on September 16, 1928 in 6 Grand Rapids, Michigan; his parents were Gerald and Marian Tow 7 Lanpher; his family eventually moved to East Moline, where he 8 graduated from United Township High School in 1946; he married 9 Jean Eileen Pulliam on December 10, 1949 at Immanuel Lutheran 10 Church in Rock Island; and

11 WHEREAS, Donald Lanpher served in the United States Marine 12 Corps from 1952 to 1954; he retired from the United States 13 Department of the Army after 37 years of service in 1983, 14 having risen from machinist apprentice to a chief in the 15 Maintenance Directorate at the United States Armament Command 16 at the Rock Island Arsenal; and
