1 SENATE RESOLUTION 2 WHEREAS, Automated traffic law enforcement systems were 3 justified as public and vehicle safety tools; and 4 WHEREAS, Studies have shown that annual crashes have 5 remained about the same before and after the installation of 6 the cameras; and 7 WHEREAS, Municipal officials and camera company executives 8 have been arrested in red light camera corruption schemes; and 9 WHEREAS, It is a goal of this body to provide greater 10 transparency and accountability in automated traffic law 11 enforcement systems; therefore, be it 12 THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL RESOLVED, BY ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that the Auditor General is 13 directed to conduct an audit of evaluating automated traffic 14 15 law enforcement systems in this State; and be it further 16 RESOLVED, That the audit include, but not be limited to, 17 the overall operation, usage, and regulation of the automated traffic law enforcement systems and any other information or 18 19 recommendations the Auditor General deems necessary; and be it
