- 9 penalty. No person shall operate a motor vehicle unless the

- 12 <u>defense to prosecution under this Section that the person</u>
- 13 operating the motor vehicle was unaware that the motor

- Any person who fails to comply with a request by a law
- 16 enforcement officer for display of evidence of insurance, as
- 17 required under Section 7-602 of this Code, shall be deemed to
