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AN ACT concerning pharmaceutical assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons
Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act is
amended by changing Section 3.15 as follows:

8 Sec. 3.15. "Covered prescription drug" means (1) any cardiovascular agent or drug; (2) any insulin or other 9 prescription drug used in the treatment of diabetes, 10 including syringe and needles used to administer the insulin; 11 (3) any prescription drug used in the treatment of arthritis, 12 13 (4) beginning on January 1, 2001, any prescription drug used in the treatment of cancer and related chronic and acute 14 15 effects or conditions, (5) beginning on January 1, 2001, any 16 prescription drug used in the treatment of Alzheimer's disease, (6) beginning on January 1, 2001, any prescription 17 18 drug used in the treatment of Parkinson's disease, (7) 19 beginning on January 1, 2001, any prescription drug used in 20 the treatment of glaucoma, and (8) beginning on January 1, 2001, any prescription drug used in the treatment of lung 21 22 disease, and smoking related illnesses, and related chronic and acute effects or conditions, and (9) beginning on January 23 1, 2002, any prescription drug used in the treatment of 24 osteoporosis. The specific agents or products to be included 25 under such categories shall be listed in a handbook to be 26 27 prepared and distributed by the Department. The general types of covered prescription drugs shall be indicated by 28 rule. The Department of Public Health shall promulgate a list 29 of covered prescription drugs under this program that meet 30 31 the definition of a narrow therapeutic index drug as
