- 16 <u>Security Act, including the continued use of federally</u>
- 17 <u>mandated enforcement remedies and techniques by the</u>

- 21 "The Department of Public Aid is exempt from the requirements
- 22 <u>of this subsection with regard to child support debts the</u>
- 23 <u>collection</u> of which is governed by the requirements of Title

- 1 IV, Part D of the federal Social Security Act. The
- 2 <u>Department of Public Aid may refer child support debts more</u>
- 3 than 90 days overdue to the State to the Unit. In the event
- 4 <u>a child support debt is referred to the Unit, the Unit must</u>
- 5 <u>use any appropriate means for collection of the debt normally</u>
- 6 available to the Unit under State law. The debt, however,

- 11 <u>mandated enforcement remedies and techniques by the</u>

- on page 8, line 31, after "Fund.", by inserting the
- 14 following:
- 15 "The provisions of this subsection do not apply to any child
- 16 support debt referred to the Unit by the Department of Public
- 17 Aid under this Section or Section 5. Collections resulting
- 18 <u>from the referrals must be distributed and disbursed at the</u>
- 19 <u>direction of the Department of Public Aid in accordance with</u>
- 20 the requirements of Title IV, Part D of the federal Social
- 21 <u>Security Act, applicable provisions of State law, and the</u>
- 22 <u>rules of the Department of Public Aid.</u>".
