- 1 AN ACT concerning forest preserve districts.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Downstate Forest Preserve District Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 7c as follows:
- 6 (70 ILCS 805/7c new)
- Sec. 7c. Conveyance of property for road purposes.
- 8 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or any other
- 9 <u>law to the contrary, a forest preserve district located in a</u>
- 10 county with a population of not less than 750,000 and not
- 11 more than 1,200,000 may not sell, lease, or convey any
- 12 <u>interest in land to any other unit of State or local</u>
- 13 government for the purpose of constructing a new roadway or
- 14 <u>widening an existing roadway on or through forest preserve</u>
- 15 <u>land unless the proposed sale, lease, or conveyance is</u>
- 16 <u>approved by a concurrence of three-fourths of all the members</u>
- of the board of commissioners and, in the case of a proposed
- 18 new roadway, submitted to the electors of the district at a
- 19 <u>regular election and approved by a majority of the electors</u>
- 20 <u>voting on the question. For any proposed new roadway on or</u>

through forest preserve land, if such a proposed sale, lease,

- 22 <u>or conveyance is approved by a concurrence of three-fourths</u>
- 23 of all commissioners, the board of commissioners shall
- 24 certify the question to the proper election authority, which
- 25 <u>must submit the question at an election in accordance with</u>
- 26 <u>the Election Code.</u>

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- 27 The question must be in substantially the following form:
- 28 <u>Shall the (insert name of forest preserve district)</u>
- 29 <u>remove land from preservation to be (insert sold, leased,</u>
- or conveyed) to (insert name of unit of State or local
- 31 government to which the land is to be sold, leased, or

- 1 <u>conveyed</u>) for the purpose of constructing a county,
- 2 <u>State, municipal, or township public road through (insert</u>
- 3 location of road).
- 4 The votes must be recorded as "Yes" or "No".
- If a majority of the electors voting on the question vote
- 6 in the affirmative, the forest preserve district may sell,
- 7 lease, or convey the land for the proposed new roadway with a
- 8 vote of concurrence by three-fourths of all members of the
- 9 <u>board of commissioners and upon such terms and conditions as</u>
- 10 the board of commissioners determines to be in the best
- 11 <u>interest of the district.</u>
- Nothing in this Section prevents or limits a forest
- 13 preserve district from constructing and maintaining its own
- 14 road network on forest preserve lands for the purposes of
- providing access to the lands and facilities of the district.
- This Section does not apply to the sale, lease, or
- 17 <u>conveyance</u> of land for improvements to existing roads
- 18 necessary for public safety that are limited to sidewalks,
- intersection improvements, and curb and gutter improvements.
