AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 448 1 AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend House Bill 448 by replacing 2 3 the title with the following: ACT in relation to assistance for low-income 4 "AN 5 persons."; and б by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 7 "Section 6. The Energy Assistance Act of 1989 is amended 8 by changing Section 6 as follows: 9 (305 ILCS 20/6) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 1406) 10 11 Sec. 6. Eligibility, Conditions of Participation, and 12 Energy Assistance. 13 (a) Any person who is a resident of the State of Illinois and whose household income is not greater than the 14 household income level established pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 15 <u>8624(b)(2)(B)</u> an---amount---determined---annually---by--the 16 17 Department,-in-consultation-with-the-Policy-Advisory-Council, may apply for assistance pursuant to this Act in accordance 18 19 with regulations promulgated by the Department. In the event that 42 U.S.C. 8624(b)(2)(B) authorizes more than one maximum 20 21 household income level, the Department shall set the eligibility level at the level that results in the largest number of persons eligible for assistance. In--setting--the annual--eligibility--level,-the-Department-shall-consider-the amount-of-available-funding-and-may-not-set--a--limit--higher than-150%-of-the-federal-nonfarm-poverty-level-as-established by-the-federal-Office-of-Management-and-Budget.

7 (b) Applicants who qualify for assistance pursuant to 8 subsection (a) of this Section shall, subject to 9 appropriation from the General Assembly and subject to availability of funds to the Department, receive energy 10 11 assistance as provided by this Act. The Department, upon receipt of monies authorized pursuant to this Act for energy 12 assistance, shall commit funds for each qualified applicant 13 in an amount determined by the Department. In determining 14 15 the amounts of assistance to be provided to or on behalf of a 16 qualified applicant, the Department shall ensure that the highest amounts of assistance go to households with the 17 18 greatest energy costs in relation to household income. The 19 Department shall include factors such as energy costs, household size, household income, and region of the State 20 21 when determining individual household benefits. In setting 22 assistance levels, the Department shall attempt to provide 23 assistance to approximately the same number of households who participated in the 1991 Residential Energy Assistance 24 25 Partnership Program. Such assistance levels shall be adjusted annually on the basis of funding availability. 26 In promulgating rules for the administration of this Section the 27 Department shall assure that a minimum of 1/3 of funds 28 available for benefits to eligible households are made 29 30 available to households who are eligible for public assistance and that elderly and disabled households are 31 32 offered a one-month application period.

33 (c) If the applicant is not a customer of an energy34 provider for winter energy services or an applicant for such

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service, such applicant shall receive a direct energy assistance payment in an amount established by the Department for all such applicants under this Act; provided, however, that such an applicant must have rental expenses for housing greater than 30% of household income.

б (d) If the applicant is a customer of an energy 7 provider, such applicant shall receive energy assistance in amount established by the Department for all such 8 an 9 applicants under this Act, such amount to be paid by the Department to the energy provider supplying winter energy 10 11 service to such applicant. Such applicant shall:

(i) make all reasonable efforts to apply to any other appropriate source of public energy assistance; and (ii) sign a waiver permitting the Department to receive income information from any public or private agency providing income or energy assistance and from any employer, whether public or private.

(e) Any qualified applicant pursuant to this Section may
receive or have paid on such applicant's behalf an emergency
assistance payment to enable such applicant to obtain access
to winter energy services. Any such payments shall be made
in accordance with regulations of the Department.
