- 4 Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 8-600 as follows:
- 6 (220 ILCS 5/8-600 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 8-600. Reliability of facilities; enforcement. The</u>
- 8 <u>Commission</u>, after notice and hearing held on complaint or on
- 9 <u>the Commission's motion, has authority to:</u>
- 10 (1) order a public utility to correct any
- 11 <u>inadequacy in service reliability in violation of or</u>
- 12 <u>non-conformance with the provisions of this Act or</u>
- 13 <u>Commission rules, including orders to perform specific</u>
- remedial actions by specified dates;
- 15 (2) impose financial penalties for violations of or
- 16 <u>non-conformances with the provisions of this Act or</u>
- 17 <u>Commission rules respecting reliability, not to exceed</u>
- 18 <u>(i) \$10,000 per occurrence or (ii) \$30,000 per day for</u>
- 19 <u>those violations or non-conformances that continue after</u>
- 20 <u>the deadline for correction established in a Commission</u>
- 21 <u>order to correct a reliability deficiency; and</u>
- 22 <u>(3) alter, modify, revoke, or suspend the</u>
