- 1 (1) Submits the vehicle to a franchised dealer for 2 a complete inspection, including fluids, frame, essential 3 parts, and other items deemed by the manufacturer as 4 essential for verification of the condition of the 5 vehicle at the time of recovery.
- 6 (2) Submits a copy of the police recovery report to 7 the inspecting dealer.
- 8 (3) Paid the inspection fee charged by the franchised dealer.
- manufacturer shall reinstate 10 The the original manufacturer's warranty if a vehicle is certified by a 11 franchised dealer as having complied with the provisions of 12 this Section.
