- 1 AN ACT concerning insurance.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 352b as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/352b new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 352b. Premium increase limits. An insurer may not</u>
- 8 <u>increase the premium charges for a constant level of coverage</u>
- 9 <u>under a group or individual policy of accident and health</u>
- 10 <u>insurance amended, delivered, issued, or renewed in this</u>
- 11 State after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the
- 12 92nd General Assembly by an amount that exceeds the
- 13 percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for Medical
- 14 Care, published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the
- 15 <u>United States Department of Labor, during the period</u>
- 16 <u>beginning on the effective date of the premium in effect at</u>
- 17 <u>the time the increase is proposed and ending on the effective</u>
- 18 <u>date of the proposed premium increase.</u> This limitation
- 19 <u>applies separately to all types of coverage provided under</u>
- 20 <u>the policy</u>. If an insurer increases or decreases a level of
- 21 <u>coverage</u>, this <u>Section</u> applies proportionately to the
- 22 <u>coverage under the policy.</u>
