AN ACT in relation to child support.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Non-Support Punishment Act is amended by5 changing Section 7 as follows:

6 (750 ILCS 16/7)

Prosecution Prosecutions by Attorney General. 7 Sec. 7. In addition to enforcement proceedings by the several State's 8 Attorneys, a proceeding for the enforcement of this Act may 9 be instituted and prosecuted by the Attorney General in 10 cases referred by the Illinois Department of Public Aid 11 involving persons receiving child and spouse support services 12 under Article X of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Before 13 referring a case to the Attorney General for enforcement 14 under this Act, the Department of Public Aid shall notify the 15 16 person receiving child and spouse support services under Article X of the Illinois Public Aid Code of the Department's 17 18 intent to refer the case to the Attorney General under this Section for prosecution. 19
