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AN ACT concerning veterans preferences.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
changing Section 10-1-16 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/10-1-16) (from Ch. 24, par. 10-1-16)

Sec. 10-1-16. <u>Veterans preferences.</u> Persons who were 7 8 engaged in the military or naval service of the United States at any time during the years 1898 through 1902, 1914 through 9 1919, at any time between September 16, 1940 and July 25, 10 1947, or at any time during the national emergency between 11 1950 and January 31, 1955, or at any time between 12 June 25, 13 January 1, 1961 and the date Congress declares the Viet Nam conflict ended, and who were honorably discharged from that 14 15 service therefrom and all persons who were engaged in the such military or naval service during any of those such years 16 who are now or may hereafter be on inactive or reserve duty 17 18 in the such military or naval service, not including, however, persons who were convicted by court-martial of 19 20 disobedience of orders, where the such disobedience consisted in the refusal to perform military service on the ground of 21 22 alleged religious or conscientious objections against war, be preferred for appointments to civil offices, 23 shall positions, and places of employment in the classified service 24 of any municipality coming under the provisions of this 25 26 Division 1, provided they are found to possess the business 27 capacity necessary for the proper discharge of the duties of such office, position, or place of employment as determined 28 by examination. The civil service commission on certifying 29 from any existing register of eligibles resulting from the 30 holding of an examination for original entrance or any 31

1 register of eligibles that may be hereafter created of 2 persons who have taken and successfully passed the examinations provided for in this Division 1 for original 3 4 entrance commencing prior to September 1, 1949, shall place 5 the name or names of such persons at the head of any existing 6 eligible register or list of eligibles that may hereafter be 7 created under the provision of this Division 1, to be 8 certified for appointment. The civil service commission shall 9 give preference for original appointment to persons as hereinabove designated whose names appear on any register of 10 11 eligibles resulting from an examination for original entrance held under the provisions of this Division 1 and commenced on 12 or after September 1, 1949 by adding to the final grade 13 average which they received or will receive as the result of 14 any examination held for original entrance, 5 points. 15 The 16 numerical result thus attained shall be applied by the civil service commission in determining the position of 17 such persons on any eligible list which has been created as 18 the 19 result of any examination for original entrance commenced on or after September 1, 1949 for purposes of preference in 20 21 certification and appointment from such eligible list.

22 Every certified civil service employee who was called to, 23 or who volunteered for, the military or naval service of the United States at any time during the years specified in this 24 25 Division 1, at any time between September 16, 1940 and July 25, 1947, or at any time during the national emergency 26 25, 1950 and January 31, 1955, or at any time 27 between June between January 1, 1961 and the date Congress declares 28 the 29 Viet Nam conflict ended, and who were honorably discharged 30 therefrom or who are now or who may hereafter be on inactive or reserve duty in such military or naval service, not 31 32 including, however, persons who were convicted by court martial of disobedience of orders where such disobedience 33 34 consisted in the refusal to perform military service on the

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1 ground of alleged religious or conscientious objections 2 against war, and whose names appear on existing promotional eligible registers or any promotional eligible register that 3 4 may hereafter be created, as provided for by this Division 1, shall be preferred for promotional appointment to civil 5 6 offices, positions and places of employment in the classified 7 civil service of any municipality coming under the provisions of this Division 1. 8

9 The civil service commission shall give preference for promotional appointment to persons as hereinabove designated 10 11 whose names appear on existing promotional eligible registers or promotional eligible registers that may hereafter be 12 13 created by adding to the final grade average which they received or will receive as the result of any promotional 14 15 examination commencing prior to September 1, 1949, six-tenths 16 of one point for each 6 months or fraction thereof of military or naval service not exceeding 30 months, and by 17 adding to the final grade average which they will receive as 18 19 the result of any promotional examinations held commencing on or after September 1, 1949 seven-tenths of one point for each 20 21 6 months or fraction thereof of military or naval service not 22 exceeding 30 months. The numerical result thus attained shall 23 be applied by the civil service commission in determining the position of such persons on any eligible list which has been 24 25 created or will be created as the result of any promotional examination held hereunder for purposes of preference in 26 certification and appointment from such eligible list. 27

No person shall receive the preference for a promotional appointment granted by this Section after he has received one promotion from an eligible list on which he was allowed such preference and which was prepared as a result of an examination held on or after September 1, 1949.

33 No person entitled to preference or credit for military 34 or naval service hereunder shall be required to furnish

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evidence or record of honorable discharge from the armed forces before the publication or posting of any eligible register or list resulting from the examination. Such preference shall be given after the posting or publication of any eligible list or register resulting from such examination and before any certifications or appointments are made from such list or register.
