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AN ACT concerning voluntary health service plans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Voluntary Health Services Plans Act is
amended by changing Section 3 as follows:

6 (215 ILCS 165/3) (from Ch. 32, par. 597)

Sec. 3. It is shall-be unlawful for any person, except a 7 8 health services plan corporation, incorporated under this Act, to establish, maintain or operate a voluntary health 9 services plan. This prohibition, however, shall not be 10 construed as preventing a person from furnishing health 11 services to his employees or from furnishing such medical 12 13 services as are required under the workers' compensation laws and related legislation, when the employees are not charged 14 for such services; nor shall it be construed to prohibit an 15 16 insurance company, or other corporation or society, which is subject to the supervision of the Director from operating in 17 18 accordance with the laws governing insurance companies or such corporations or societies; nor shall it be construed to 19 20 prohibit the continued operation of any medical or health service plan in existence and functioning at the effective 21 22 date of this Act.
