AN ACT in relation to public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 changing Section 5-12 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-12) (from Ch. 23, par. 5-12)

7 Sec. 5-12. Funeral and burial. Upon the death of а recipient who qualified under class 2, 3 or 4 of Section 5-2, 8 if his estate is insufficient to pay his funeral and burial 9 expenses and if no other resources, including assistance from 10 legally responsible relatives, are available for those such 11 purposes, there shall be paid, in accordance with the 12 standards, rules and regulations of the Illinois Department 13 of Human Services, the such reasonable amounts that are as 14 may--be necessary to meet costs of the funeral, burial space, 15 16 and cemetery charges, or to reimburse any person not financially responsible for the deceased who has have 17 voluntarily made expenditures for those such costs. 18
