- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Fertilizer Act of 1961 is
- 5 amended by changing Section 6b as follows:
- 6 (505 ILCS 80/6b) (from Ch. 5, par. 55.6b)
- 7 Sec. 6b. <u>Fertilizer Control Fund.</u> The amount annually
- 8 deposited in the Fertilizer Control Fund shall be
- 9 appropriated for the operation of the Fertilizer Research and
- 10 Education Program.
- 11 These moneys shall be used for expenses consistent with
- 12 carrying out the purpose and intent of the program, which
- include council expenses, peer review, and contracts to
- 14 persons for research or education projects and costs
- 15 associated with general operating expenses, such as
- 16 administrative support, travel, commodities, and printing.
- 17 The Department shall receive 3% of the annual amount
- deposited in the Fertilizer Control Fund.
