- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Pesticide Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 60/2) (from Ch. 5, par. 802)
- 7 Sec. 2. Declaration of Purpose: The purpose of this Act
- 8 is to regulate in the public interest the labeling,
- 9 distribution, use and application of pesticides as herein
- 10 defined <u>in this Act</u>. It is recognized that pesticides are
- 11 valuable and necessary to Illinois' agricultural production
- and to the protection of man and his environment from pests,
- 13 but it is essential to our general health and welfare that
- 14 they be regulated to prevent adverse effects on man and his
- 15 environment. New pesticides and application methods are
- 16 continually being synthesized or discovered which may be
- 17 valuable for pest control. However, such pesticides may
- 18 cause unreasonable adverse effects on the environment or may
- 19 be injurious to animals or man if not properly used. It is,
- 20 therefore, deemed necessary to provide for the regulation of
- 21 pesticides.
