- 1 AN ACT in relation to firearms.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 3.5 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 65/3.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3.5. Private transfers of firearms by persons</u>
- 8 <u>attending gun shows.</u>
- 9 (a) Any person who is not a federally licensed firearm
- 10 <u>dealer who desires to transfer a firearm while that person is</u>
- on the grounds of a gun show must do so only through a
- 12 <u>federally licensed firearm dealer. The dealer must follow</u>
- 13 the procedure set forth in Section 3.1 of this Act as if the
- dealer were the seller of the firearm.
- 15 <u>(b) In this Act:</u>
- 16 <u>"Gun show" means an event or function sponsored by a</u>
- 17 <u>national</u>, <u>state</u>, <u>or local organization devoted to the</u>
- 18 <u>collection</u>, <u>competitive use</u>, <u>or other sporting use of</u>
- 19 <u>firearms</u>, or an event or an organization or association that
- 20 sponsors functions or events devoted to the collection,
- 21 <u>competitive use</u>, or other sporting use of firearms in the
- 22 <u>community.</u>
- 23 <u>"Grounds of a gun show" means the geographical area in</u>
- 24 which the gun show is located, including any areas used for
- 25 parking for the gun show.
