redemption is made, from any sale made under any judgment 21 foreclosing the lien of taxes, no waste shall be committed or 22 23 suffered on any of the mobile homes involved. The mobile home shall be maintained in good condition and repair. When 24 25 violations of local building, health, or safety codes or violations of mobile home park rules and regulations make the 26 mobile home dangerous or hazardous, when taxes on the mobile 27 home are delinquent for 2 years or more, or when in the 28 judgment of the court it is to the best interest of the 29 parties, the court may, upon the verified petition of any 30 party to the proceeding, or the holder of the certificate of 31 purchase, appoint a receiver for the mobile home with like 32 powers and duties of receivers as in cases of foreclosure of 33
