- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by
- 5 adding Section 17-25 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/ 17-25 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 17-25. Written approval of telephone directory</u>
- 8 <u>advertisements.</u>
- 9 <u>(a) In this Section:</u>
- 10 <u>"Advertisement" means a listing of the name, address,</u>
- 11 <u>telephone number, e-mail address, or other information</u>
- 12 <u>concerning a business.</u>
- 13 <u>"Business" means a place where a trade or occupation is</u>
- 14 conducted, services are offered for sale to the public, or
- 15 where tangible personal property is displayed, held, stored,
- or offered for sale to the public.
- 17 <u>"Business" also includes a place where a public officer</u>
- 18 <u>or employee conducts any business. "Business" does not</u>
- include a place that serves only as a residence.
- 20 <u>"Internet" means an interactive computer service or</u>
- 21 system or an information service, system, or access software
- 22 provider that provides or enables computer access by
- 23 <u>multiple users to a computer server, and includes, but is not</u>
- 24 <u>limited to, an information service, system, or access</u>
- 25 <u>software provider that provides access to a network</u>
- 26 system commonly known as the Internet, or any comparable
- 27 system or service and also includes, but is not limited
- 28 to, a World Wide Web page, newsgroup, message board, mailing

- 31 <u>"Access" and "computer" have the meanings ascribed</u>

- 1 to them in Section 16D-2 of this Code.
- 2 <u>"Telephone directory" means a listing of business names</u>
- 3 and addresses, whether printed or available on the Internet.
- 4 (b) It is unlawful for a person to knowingly publish or
- 5 <u>cause to be published in a telephone directory an</u>
- 6 advertisement for a business without the written consent of
- 7 <u>the owner of the business.</u>
- 8 (c) Sentence. A violation of this Section is a petty
- 9 offense for which the court must sentence the offender to a
- 10 fine of \$500. Each publication of an advertisement for a
- 11 <u>business</u> without the written approval of the owner of the
- business is a separate offense.
- 13 (d) It is a defense to a violation of this Section that
- 14 the person who published the advertisement or caused the
- 15 <u>advertisement to be published made a reasonable effort to</u>
- 16 contact the owner of the business and obtain the consent of
- 17 the owner of the business before publication of the
- 18 <u>advertisement.</u>
