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AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 1. Section 6. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Indoor Radon Mitigation Fund to the Department of Nuclear Safety for expenses relating to the federally funded State Indoor Radon Abatement Program.

27 Section 7. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as 28 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Low-Level 29 Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to 30 the Department of Nuclear Safety for use in accordance with 31 Section 14(a) of the Illinois Low-Level Radioactive Waste 32 Management Act for costs related to establishing a low-level

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1 radioactive waste disposal facility.

Section 8. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 2 3 necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation may be Protection Fund to the Department of Nuclear Safety for 4 5 licensing facilities where radioactive uranium and thorium mill tailings are generated or located, and related costs for 6 7 regulating the decontamination and decommissioning of such 8 facilities and for identification, decontamination and monitoring 9 environmental of unlicensed properties 10 contaminated with such radioactive mill tailings.

11 Section 9. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 13 Protection Fund to the Department of Nuclear Safety for 14 reimbursing other governmental agencies for their assistance 15 in responding to radiological emergencies.

16 Section 10. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as 17 be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation mav 18 Protection Fund to the Department of Nuclear Safety for 19 recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and 20 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available 21 22 surety.

Section 11. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 23 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 24 25 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Department of 26 Nuclear Safety for related training and travel expenses and to reimburse the Illinois State Police and the Illinois 27 28 Commerce Commission for costs incurred for activities related 29 to inspecting and escorting shipments of spent nuclear fuel, 30 high-level radioactive waste, and transuranic waste in

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Illinois as provided under the rules of the Department.

2 Section 12. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield Agreed Order Fund to the Department of Nuclear Safety for the care, 4 5 maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site near б Sheffield, Illinois. 7

Section 13. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as 8 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation Protection Fund to the Department of Nuclear Safety to 10 conduct studies, investigations, training, research and 11 12 demonstrations relating to the control or measurement of radiation, the effects on health of exposure to radiation, 13 14 and related problems under funding agreements with the Federal Government, interstate agencies or other sources. 15

16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1, 2001. 17

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
