- 4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 9-25 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 9-25. <u>Prohibited contributions.</u>
- 8 (a) No person shall make an anonymous contribution or a
- 9 contribution in the name of another person, and no person
- 10 shall knowingly accept any anonymous contribution or
- 11 contribution made by one person in the name of another
- 12 person.
- 13 (b) No person may solicit any full-time or part-time
- 14 <u>State employee for a contribution to a political committee of</u>
- 15 <u>a General Assembly member, a statewide executive branch</u>
- 16 <u>constitutional officer</u>, or a <u>candidate</u> for the <u>General</u>
- 17 <u>Assembly or a statewide executive branch constitutional</u>
- 18 office. As used in this subsection, "statewide executive
- 19 <u>branch constitutional officer" and "statewide executive</u>
- 20 <u>branch constitutional office" mean the Governor, Lieutenant</u>
- 21 Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, State
- 22 <u>Treasurer</u>, and State Comptroller.
- 23 (c) Anenymous Contributions made in violation of this
- 24 <u>Section</u> shall escheat to the State of Illinois. Any political
