- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

- 4 Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by adding

- 7 <u>Sec. 15-167. Circuit breaker recipient. Property owned</u>
- 8 and used exclusively as a home by a claimant under the Senior
