AN ACT concerning schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Construction Law is amended by
changing Section 5-35 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 230/5-35)

Sec. 5-35. School construction project grant amounts;
permitted use; prohibited use.

(a) The product of the district's grant index and the 9 recognized project cost, as determined by the Capital 10 Development Board, for an approved school 11 construction project shall equal the amount of the grant the Capital 12 13 Development Board shall provide to the eligible district. The grant index shall not be used in cases where the General 14 Assembly and the Governor approve appropriations designated 15 16 for specifically identified school district construction projects. 17

(b) In each fiscal year in which school construction project grants are awarded, 20% of the total amount awarded statewide shall be awarded to a school district with a population exceeding 500,000, provided such district complies with the provisions of this Article.

In addition to the uses otherwise authorized by this Law, 23 any school district with a population exceeding 500,000 is 24 authorized to use any or all of the school construction 25 project grants (i) to pay debt service, as defined in the 26 27 Local Government Debt Reform Act, on bonds, as defined in the Local Government Debt Reform Act, issued to finance one or 28 29 more school construction projects and (ii) to the extent that any such bond is a lease or other installment or financing 30 contract between the school district and a public building 31

1 commission that has issued bonds to finance one or more 2 qualifying school construction projects, to make lease 3 payments under the lease.

4 (b-5) Any school district that leases a school building 5 from a municipality under an agreement involving the sale of 6 certificates of participation is eligible to receive a grant 7 under this Law, provided that the term of the lease is 8 sufficient to cover the estimated life of the building and 9 the lease is not subject to forfeiture or termination.

10 (c) No portion of a school construction project grant 11 awarded by the Capital Development Board shall be used by a 12 school district for any on-going operational costs.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1, 2001.
