- 13 <u>evidence of a sexual assault or abuse from alleged sexual</u>
- 14 <u>assault or abuse survivors under the Sexual Assault Survivors</u>
- 15 <u>Emergency Treatment Act is qualified to testify at trial as</u>
- 16 <u>an expert on emergency services provided to sexual assault</u>
- 17 <u>survivors if the hospital in which the nurse is employed uses</u>
