9 are to be remitted.

10 (b) On receipt of a request for registration, the 11 registering tribunal shall cause the order to be filed as a 12 foreign judgment, together with one copy of the documents and 13 information, regardless of their form.

14 (c) A petition or comparable pleading seeking a remedy 15 that must be affirmatively sought under other law of this 16 State may be filed at the same time as the request for 17 registration or later. The pleading must specify the grounds 18 for the remedy sought.
