- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 7-109.3 and adding Section 7-109.4 as

- 7 (40 ILCS 5/7-109.3) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 7-109.3)
- 8 Sec. 7-109.3. "Sheriff's Law Enforcement Employees".
