- 7 Sec. 27-3. Patriotism and principles of representative
- 8 government Proper use of flag Method of voting Pledge
- 9 of Allegiance. American patriotism and the principles of

- 11 Declaration of Independence, the Constitution of the United
- 12 States of America and the Constitution of the State of
- 13 Illinois, and the proper use and display of the American
- 14 flag, shall be taught in all public schools and other
- 15 educational institutions supported or maintained in whole or
