- 4 Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding

- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on July 1, 2005)
- 8 Sec. 13-408. Priority access to cellular telephone
- 9 <u>service</u> for <u>emergency</u> <u>service</u> <u>providers</u>. A
- 10 <u>telecommunications</u> carrier offering cellular telephone
- 11 service shall, to the extent technically feasible, make
- 12 <u>available to emergency service providers including, but not</u>
- 13 <u>limited to, fire departments, emergency medical service</u>
- 14 providers, and law enforcement agencies, priority access to
- 15 <u>cellular telephone</u> <u>service</u> <u>in</u> <u>order</u> <u>to</u> <u>assure</u> <u>its</u>
- 16 <u>availability during a public emergency</u>. <u>Telecommunications</u>
- 17 <u>carriers may consult with the Department of Public Health</u>,
