- 4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended
- 5 by adding Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/2 new)
- Sec. 2. Ronald Reagan Day. February 6th of each year is
- 8 <u>designated</u> as <u>Ronald</u> <u>Reagan</u> <u>Day</u>, to be observed throughout
- 9 the State as a day set apart to honor the 40th President of
- 10 <u>the United States of America who came from humble beginnings</u>
- in Illinois and worked throughout his life serving the cause
- of freedom and advancing the public good.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 14 becoming law.
