AN ACT concerning regional planning.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Regional Planning Commission Act is
5 amended by changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 15/1) (from Ch. 85, par. 1021)

Sec. 1. Joint planning commissions. Governing bodies of 7 8 counties, cities, or other local governmental units, when authorized by the Department of Commerce and Community 9 Affairs, may cooperate with the governing bodies of the 10 counties and cities or other governing bodies of 11 any adjoining state or states in the creation of a joint planning 12 13 commission where such cooperation has been authorized by law by the adjoining state or states. Such a joint planning 14 15 commission may be designated to be a regional or metropolitan planning commission and shall have powers, duties and 16 functions as authorized by "An Act to provide for regional 17 18 planning and for the creation, organization and powers of regional planning commissions", approved June 25, 1929, as 19 heretofore or hereafter amended, and, as agreed among the 20 governing bodies. Such a planning commission shall be a legal 21 22 entity for all purposes.
