Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Housing Authorities Act is amended by
changing Section 8.3 as follows:

6 (310 ILCS 10/8.3) (from Ch. 67 1/2, par. 8.3)

Sec. 8.3. Power to lease, rent, and take other actions 7 8 with respect to property. An Authority has power to lease or rent any of the housing or other accommodations or any of the 9 lands, buildings, structures, or facilities embraced in any 10 project and to establish and revise the rents or charges 11 therefor; to purchase, lease, obtain options upon, acquire by 12 13 eminent domain or otherwise, sell, exchange, transfer or assign, any property, real or personal, or any interest 14 15 therein; to acquire any property, real or personal, or any 16 interest therein from any firm, corporation or any municipal, State or Federal government or any agency, instrumentality or 17 18 subdivision thereof by gift, grant, or legacy; to own, hold, clear and improve property; in its discretion to insure or 19 20 provide for the insurance of the property or operations of the Authority against such risks as the Authority may deem 21 22 advisable.
