- 1 AN ACT in relation to children.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 7.4 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 505/7.4 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 7.4. Placement of siblings.</u>
- 8 (a) When a child is in need of an adoptive placement,
- 9 the Department shall examine its files and other available
- 10 <u>resources and attempt to determine whether any biological</u>
- 11 sibling of the child has been adopted. If the Department
- 12 <u>determines that a biological sibling of the child has been</u>
- 13 <u>adopted</u>, the <u>Department shall</u> <u>make a good faith effort to</u>
- 14 locate the adoptive parents of the sibling and inform them of
- the availability of the child for adoption.
- 16 (b) If the adoptive parents of a biological sibling of a
- 17 <u>child available for adoption apply to adopt that child, the</u>
- 18 Department shall consider them as adoptive applicants for the
- 19 <u>adoption of the child. The Department's final decision,</u>
- 20 <u>however, shall be based upon the welfare and best interest of</u>
- 21 <u>the child. In arriving at its decision, the Department shall</u>
- 22 <u>consider all relevant factors, including but not limited to:</u>
- 23 (1) the wishes of the child;
- 24 (2) the interaction and interrelationship of the
- 25 <u>child with the applicant to adopt the child;</u>

7	(c) The Department may refuse to inform the adoptive
8	parents of a biological sibling of a child that the child is
9	available for adoption, as required under subsection (a),
10	only for a reason permitted under criteria adopted by the
11	Department by rule.
