- 5 Practices Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 2. <u>Unlawful practice; federal law.</u> Unfair methods
- 8 of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices,
- 9 including but not limited to the use or employment of any
- 10 deception, fraud, false pretense, false promise, or
- 11 misrepresentation, or the concealment, suppression, or
- 12 omission of any material fact, with intent that others rely
- 13 upon the concealment, suppression, or omission of such
- 14 material fact, or the use or employment of any practice
- 15 described in Section 2 of the "Uniform Deceptive Trade
- 16 Practices Act#,--approved--August-5,-1965, in the conduct of
- 17 any trade or commerce are hereby declared unlawful whether
