- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)
- 8 Sec. 21. Penalty . Any person who violates this Act or
- 9 any rule or regulation adopted by the Department, or who
- 10 violates any determination or order of the Department under
- 11 this Act shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor and shall
- 12 be fined a sum not less than \$100. A person convicted of a
- 13 <u>second</u> or <u>subsequent violation of subsections (a) or (f) of</u>
- 14 <u>Section 4 of this Act is guilty of a Class 4 felony.</u>
- 15 Each day's violation constitutes a separate offense. The
- 16 State's Attorney of the county in which the violation
- occurred or the Attorney General shall bring such actions in
- 18 the name of the people of the State of Illinois.

- 20 Section 10. The Illinois Pesticide Act is amended by
- 21 changing Section 24 as follows:

- 2 Sec. 24. Criminal Penalties.
- 3 1. Except as otherwise provided in this Section, any
- 4 person violating any provisions of this Act or regulations
- 5 adopted thereunder <u>is</u> shall--be guilty of a Class A
- 6 misdemeanor with a fine of not less than \$5,000.
- 7 <u>2. A retailer convicted of distributing or selling a</u>
- 8 pesticide not registered with the United States Environmental
- 9 Protection Agency and the Illinois Department of Agriculture
- 10 shall be quilty of a Class A misdemeanor with a fine of not
- 11 <u>less than \$5,000.</u> A retailer convicted of a second or
- 12 <u>subsequent violation of distributing or selling a pesticide</u>
- 13 <u>not registered with the United States Environmental</u>
- 14 Protection Agency and the Illinois Department of Agriculture
- shall be guilty of a Class 4 felony. For the purposes of
- 16 <u>this Section, "retailer" means a person who transfers</u>
- ownership of or title to pesticides to a purchaser for use.
- 3. A wholesaler who distributes or sells a pesticide not
- 19 <u>registered with the United States Environmental Protection</u>
- 20 Agency and the Illinois Department of Agriculture shall be
- 21 guilty of a Class 4 felony for a first offense and shall be
- 22 guilty of a Class 3 felony for a second or subsequent
- offense. For the purposes of this Section, "wholesaler" means
- 24 <u>a person who sells or distributes pesticides to a retailer.</u>
